Notes:

1. Commercial/Industrial:

- a. Service fees are on a per acre basis.
- b. Payment of service fees allots up to 12.5 PE per acre to the development. Any projected discharges greater than 12.5 PE per acre will be charged excess service fees at \$720 per PE. One P.E. is equal to 100 gallons per day.
- c. First phase service fees are due at the time of annexation.
- d. Second phase service fees are due at the time of IEPA permit application or may be differed by written request up to 5 years or to third phase, whichever is sooner.
- e. Third phase (and any differed fees) are due prior to issuance of building permit.

2. Residential:

- a. For a single home construction by an individual on a single lot, the service fee is due prior to issuance of building permit.
- b. For residential developments, a minimum of 40 units of residential service fee are due at the time of annexation.
- c. Additional development phases are due at a minimum of 40 units or remaining platted units, whichever number is lower.
