ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

PUMP STATION 31 FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT
FOR THE
ALBIN D. PAGORSKI WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY
FOX RIVER WATER RECLAMATION DISTRICT
ELGIN, ILLINOIS

The Fox River Water Reclamation District will receive sealed Bids for Pump Station 31 Force Main Replacement for the Albin D. Pagorski Water Reclamation Facility (ADP WRF) until 2 P.M., local time, June 26, 2018, at 1957 LaFox (Route 31 and Dana Drive), South Elgin, IL 60177, at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work will take place between Pump Station 31 on lower Wellington Avenue and the ADP WRF in Elgin. The work includes installation of approximately 2,282 lineal feet of new 24-inch diameter force main and associated valves and structures to serve the existing and new Pump Station 31 while maintaining the existing 24-inch force main for emergency purposes. The work also includes replacement of an existing City of Elgin sanitary sewer with approximately 846 lineal feet of new 15-inch sanitary sewer. The work also includes installation of a conduit raceway system along the route of the new force main for fiber-optic cabling (cabling provided as part of a separate concurrent project) from the new Pump Station 31 to five existing structures at the ADP WRF.

Bids are to be addressed to the Fox River Water Reclamation District, 1957 LaFox (Route 31 and Dana Drive), South Elgin, IL 60177, and shall be marked "Sealed Bid-Pump Station 31 Force Main Replacement."

Bidding Documents may be reviewed and paper copies, along with a compact disk of applicable record drawings for the project, may be obtained from the Issuing Office which is Strand Associates, Inc.[®], 910 West Wingra Drive, Madison, WI 53715. A nonrefundable fee of \$150 will be required (shipping and handling fees included). Overnight mailing of Bidding Documents will not be provided.

All Bidders submitting a sealed Bid shall obtain the Bidding Documents from QuestCDN.com or from Strand Associates, Inc.[®]

Bidders who submit a Bid must be a Plan Holder of record at the Issuing Office. Bids from Bidders who are not on the Plan Holders List may be returned as not being responsive.

Plan Holders are requested to provide an e-mail address if they wish to receive addenda and other information electronically. Plan Holders are requested to designate whether they are a prime contractor, subcontractor, or supplier if they want this information posted on the project Plan Holders List.

The Bid must be accompanied by Bid security made payable to OWNER in an amount of 10% of the Bidder's maximum Bid price.

Wage rates for the Work shall be not less than the current prevailing wages established for the Kane County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois and the U.S. Department of Labor under the Davis-Bacon and related Acts. CONTRACTOR shall comply with the then current prevailing wages. If at the time this Contract is executed, or if during the term of this Contract, there is excessive unemployment in Illinois as defined in the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act, 30 ILCS 570, as two consecutive months of unemployment exceeding 5%, CONTRACTOR agrees to employ a work force that consists of at least 90% Illinois laborers. An "Illinois laborer" is defined as any person who has resided in Illinois for at least 30 days and intends to become or remain an Illinois resident. The Bidder shall require all subcontractors (if any) to conform with said laws, and any rules or regulations now and thereafter issued pursuant to said laws by Bidder, his subcontractors, and/or anyone working through or on behalf of Bidder or Bidder's subcontractors.

The Fox River Water Reclamation District reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any technicality, and to accept any Bid which it deems advantageous. All Bids shall remain subject to acceptance for 60 days after the time set for receiving Bids.

Contract award shall be made based on the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder.

A nonmandatory prebid conference will be held at 10 A.M., local time, on June 12, 2018, at the Fox River Water Reclamation District Administration Building on Dana Drive, South Elgin, IL 60177. Bidders are encouraged to attend and participate in the conference.
