ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

ALBIN D. PAGORSKI WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY
PHOSPHORUS REMOVAL - STRUVITE FACILITIES
FOX RIVER WATER RECLAMATION DISTRICT
ELGIN, ILLINOIS

The Fox River Water Reclamation District will receive sealed Bids for the Albin D. Pagorski (ADP) Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Phosphorus Removal – Struvite Facilities Project until 2 p.m., local time, April 24, 2019, at the Fox River Water Reclamation District, 1957 LaFox (Route 31 and Dana Drive), South Elgin, Illinois 60177 at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposed work is generally described as follows:

The work includes the construction of a new Struvite Removal Building, fluidized-bed Struvite Reactor, and odor control system. The Struvite Building will include a below-grade mixing pump station which will serve two new Sludge Equalization Tanks. New equipment, piping, and appurtenances will be installed. This equipment will include feed, recirculation/transfer, and jet mixing pumps; a magnesium chloride storage and feed system; an anti-foam chemical storage and feed system; reactor blowers; and associated HVAC, electrical, and I&C systems.

Bids are to be addressed to the Fox River Water Reclamation District, 1957 LaFox (Route 31 and Dana Drive), South Elgin, Illinois 60177 and shall be marked “Sealed Bid – ADP WRF Phosphorus Removal – Struvite Facilities – Do Not Open”.

Bidder’s attention is directed to Section 00 73 00C for State Wage Rates and to Section 00 73 00D for Davis-Bacon Wage Act Clauses and Wages.

Any Contract awarded under this Advertisement to Bid is expected to be funded in part by a loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). Neither the State of Illinois nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party of this Advertisement for Bid or any resulting Contract. The procurement will be subject to regulations contained in the procedures for issuing loans from the Water Pollution Control Loan Program (WPCLP) as set out in Part 365 of the Illinois Administrative Code – Title 35; the Davis-Bacon Act [40 USC 276a through 276a-5], as defined by the U.S. Department of Labor; the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act [30 ILCS 570]; the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise program requirements [40 CFR Part 33]; and the “Use of American Iron and Steel” requirements as contained in Section 436 of H.R. 3547, the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014. This procurement is also subject to the loan recipient’s policy regarding the increased use of disadvantaged business enterprises. The loan recipient’s policy requires all bidders to undertake specified affirmative efforts at least sixteen (16) days prior to the

day of the bid opening. The policy is contained in the Project Manual. Bidders are also required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246, as amended. The requirements for Bidders and Contractors under this order are explained in 41 CFR 60-4.

Contract award shall be made based on the lowest responsive and responsible Bidder.

Prebid conferences will be held at 10:00 a.m. local time, on March 19 and April 9, 2019, at the Fox River Water Reclamation District, 1957 LaFox (Route 31 and Dana Drive), South Elgin, Illinois 60177. Representatives of OWNER and ENGINEER will be present to discuss the project and make a tour of the site (located at 100 Purify Drive, Elgin, IL 60120). **Bidders are required to attend at least one of the two conferences.**
